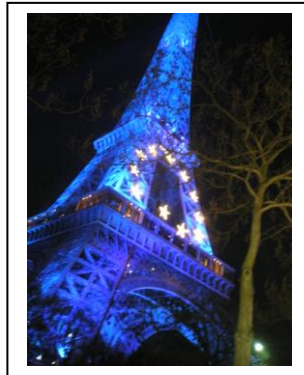
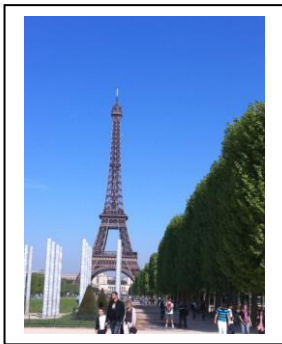

7.15pm Dinner at the Eiffel Tower and afterwards a Seine River Cruise

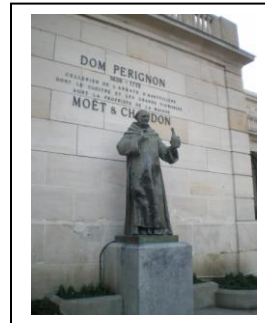

A late trip home...we may even have dinner in Epernay.

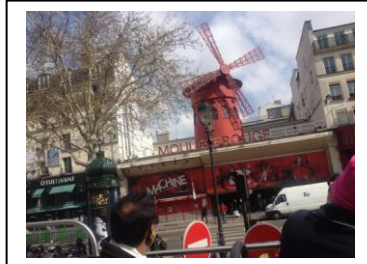


20th April

Thursday**

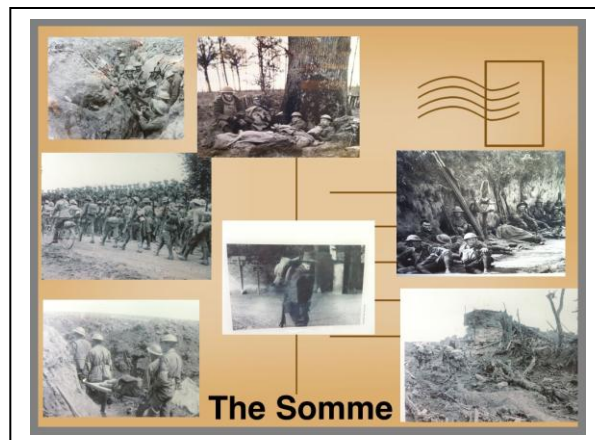

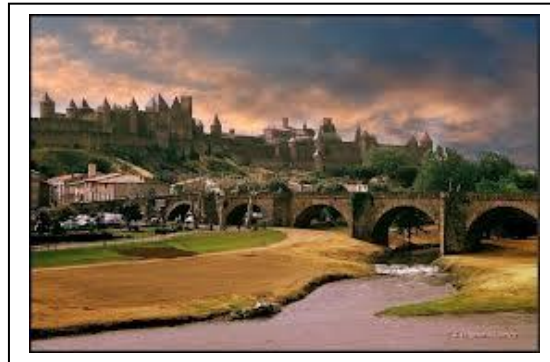
In Carcassone we are staying in villas in the new town just outside the UNESCO world heritage walled city.
